Subject: Memo Regarding Disinfecting Equipment

Dear Valued Partner:

Considering the COVID-19 (coronavirus) detections within the United States, we want to pass on the following information about disinfecting equipment bearing the trademarks of The Coca-Cola Company.

Food Contact Surfaces

The World Health Organization is not recommending any changes to standard sanitation or cleaning practices for food contact surfaces.

Non-Food Contact Surfaces

If you would like to take measures to disinfect non-food contact surfaces, the following products suggested by the American Chemistry Council are compatible with our trademarked equipment:

- i7 Disinfectant Wipes (Ecolab Inc/Kay Chemical Co.) EPA Reg No. 6836-340-1677
- Clorox Disinfecting Wipes (The Clorox Company) EPA Reg No. 5813-79
- PURELL® Foodservice Surface Sanitizer (GOJO Industries, Inc.) EPA Reg No. 84368-1-84150

You can find a list of other disinfectants that are expected to be effective against the Virus at the website below. If you decide to use a disinfectant not listed above, we recommend testing the disinfectant in an inconspicuous place on the equipment following the manufacturer's instructions for use. If the appearance of the area does not change (e.g., no discoloration or hazing), you can proceed to use the disinfectant. If there is any change in the appearance over time, discontinue use immediately and contact 1-800-241-COKE. Link to other disinfectants:
